Through Exchange Program with local school - Showing Japanese Culture -

In June, representatives of students from Al Ittihad School, who was visited us for an exchange program in May, visited our school for an exchange program. The opening ceremony was held in the school auditorium. After a welcome speech by the student council president, the G3 and G4 students performed "Sakura," an ensemble and chorus song. After the opening ceremony, the exchange activities were held in the gymnasium, focusing on Japanese cultural experiences. Each grade was in charge of a booth for "Japanese tea ceremony," "Japanese calligraphy," "ink painting," "fan painting," "origami," and "Japanese traditional games," and they prepared for this event. On the day of the event, students gave explanations in English and Arabic so that the students from Al Ittihad School were able to easily understand.


In the tea ceremony experience, we were treated to tea by members of the "Urasenke Abu Dhabi Tea Ceremony Group."
