Resuming swimming lessons - Thanks to Al Ghazali School -


Swimming lessons, which had been suspended since 2020 due to the Covid-19, have resumed for the first time in three years. We believe that the students' good manners and willingness to learn to swim until 2019 led us to get permission pleasantly to use the school this time, after three years. We are grateful to our neighbouring Al Ghazali School and thankful to our school's traditions and seniors.

The pool is an all-weather indoor pool and is properly maintained in terms of room and water temperature. The learning environment is excellent as a swimming lesson, but walking to the school is a problem. It is 350 meters from our school to the Al Ghazali School. Upper and lower year students are paired up and walk hand in hand to Al Ghazali School. The distance is short, but the problem is the temperature. Until September, when the temperature rises to nearly 50 degrees Celsius by 11.30am, the journey for 350 meters is dangerous. Therefore, we started swimming lessons in October, when the temperatures are stable.

It is also the first time in three years that the children have learnt to swim; for Grade 4 and below, it is their first time in a swimming lesson at our school. The children's swimming skills also have to rely on assessment from their parents. From G1 to G9 students learn together. As the depth of the pool varies from place to place, the children learn in groups according to their swimming skills, with height taken into account. This is the first time for teachers to enter the pool there. We have conducted a preview, simulated the location and contents of the activities and planned them with safety as the top priority.

The pool is staffed with two resident swimming coaches and two lifeguards. This is when the first swim lesson is over. A lifeguard approached us. "The coaching from the teachers were very good!" Next, we were approached by a swimming coach. "Japanese teachers' coaching is great. Good!" Finally, the manager gave his impressions of the learning activities. "The students greeted us cheerfully from the moment they arrived here. When the teacher began to explain, they listened silently without talking. When they listened to one teacher's whistle while they were swimming, they all got out of the pool and lined up as soon as they were out of the pool. The Emirati students were listening just as much as the Japanese students. The teachers' coaching is great, and the kids have a great attitude about learning."

We will continue to teach "politeness," "moderation," and "learning discipline including an attitude of listening," so that the good traditions of the Abu Dhabi Japanese School will be reflected in the children's daily words and actions.
