203 people (as of January 10th) lost their lives in the Noto Earthquake that occurred in Ishikawa Prefecture on January 1st. We sincerely pray for the repose of their souls. In addition, 68 people are still unaccounted for and more than 20,000 people were affected by the disaster. I would like to take this opportunity to express my sincere condolences and sympathies to all those who were affected.

“Good morning.”

On the morning of the Opening Ceremony, students’ cheerful voices echoed in the school. At the Opening Ceremony, I talked about the earthquake that hit the Noto region of Ishikawa Prefecture on New Year’s Day. I told the students that many people in Japan were refraining from celebrating the New Year. I also told them how thankful I was that they came to school without any problems.

I told them about another incident, the Haneda Airport accident on the 2nd. Many foreign media praised the 379 passengers and crew for their safe evacuation. I believe that it was because of the crew's daily training that they were able to calmly lead the evacuation and ensure the safety of all the passengers. I also believe that the miraculous escape of the passengers was made possible because they followed the instructions and guidance of the crew and act in an orderly manner.

Japan is a country with many disasters. Schools in Japan conduct drills throughout the year to prepare for fires, earthquakes, and suspicious persons. We will continue to train so that we can act to protect our own lives.

I hope that the students will take pride in studying at Japanese School in Abu Dhabi as Japanese people or as students who learn through Japanese styled education, while being thankful for their daily lives. We will continue to nurture human resources to serve as a bridge between the UAE and Japan. Thank you very much for your cooperation.
